# HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

## COVID-19 Addendum

By sending your child to school  
you consent to this agreement

## In re-admitting your child to BCCHS, as a school we will:

- Provide a safe environment for students by taking extra precautions including:
  - ♦ Teaching students in isolated year group “bubbles”.
  - ♦ Providing extra cleaning facilities.
  - ♦ Ensuring adequate time to maintain good hygiene.
  - ♦ Ensuring social distancing can be maintained during break and lunch.
  - ♦ Following Government guidelines when completing COVID-19 risk assessment.
- Provide training for all staff.
- Adequately brief students on new procedures in school.
- Insist students observe our behaviour and anti-bullying policies.
- Adhere to social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can, both in and out of school.
- Provide a curriculum that meets mental health, wellbeing, and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if their child displays COVID-19 symptoms.
- Follow latest Government guidelines should staff or student show COVID-19 symptoms.
- Continue a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in our Behaviour Policy, as well as expectations outlined in this agreement and COVID-19 Behaviour procedures.
- Communicate through notices, text, email and our school website.

## In accepting a place for my child, as a parent I will ensure:

- Not to send my child to school if they or another household member shows COVID-19 symptoms. I will telephone school, self-isolate our family for 14 days, and arrange testing.
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect them immediately.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will:
  - ♦ Adhere to social distancing rules.
  - ♦ Remain in my vehicle.
  - ♦ Not enter the building unless a prior appointment has been made.
- My child will only bring necessary items.
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules, but accept they are hard to follow and understand that they may not always be able to follow them.
- I accept that my child may have their temperature taken, using a non-contact thermometer, if they feel unwell.
- I will support staff in their efforts to create a safe as possible environment by:
  - ♦ Teaching my child how to wash their hands properly.
  - ♦ Remind them about “Catch it”, “Bin it” and “Kill it” for coughs and sneezes.
  - ♦ Maintain up to date contacts details.
  - ♦ Read all letters/messages/emails.
  - ♦ Ensure my child attends school in clean school trousers/skirt and shirt.
- Understand that if my child is unwell at school they will be immediately isolated.
- If my child or their actions are deemed unsafe they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

## Returning to BCCHS, as a student I will:

- Ensure I follow a robust hygiene routine before coming to school.
- Follow the social distancing rules in class, in the toilets, and on the corridors.
- Only bring things into school that are necessary for each school day.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated doors.
- Remain in the designated area of school during break and lunchtime.
- Wash hands regularly using soap and water for 20 seconds or hand sanitiser.
- Behave well at all times to keep myself and others safe.
- Follow safety rules and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and not allowed into school until I can be safe.
