Assessment Breakdown	Internal based assessment. Portfolio of evidence and performance.
Course Outline	<p>Units 1,2,3: These Units focus on devising, rehearsing and performing. Students work in small groups to create a performance. They spend time rehearsing the performance so it is ready for an audience.</p> <p>These units help to give students an understanding of the demands of a performer.</p> <p>The final performance is filmed and then this is viewed by an external moderator. All other evidence is gathered throughout the rehearsal stage. Evidence can take the form of: photographs, written reflections, storyboards and diary entry.</p> <p>Unit 8: This unit focuses on the different roles that people do backstage. Students look at a variety of different jobs and the skills needed to complete those jobs. Research includes the work of a make-up artist and the job a crew member does.</p> <p>Students also focus on how performers prepare for their performances.</p> <p>Again evidence is collected throughout the lessons. Students create a portfolio of work which is internally marked and then externally moderated.</p>
