- Offer a range of extra-curricular activities for your child to engage in after school.
- Support your child to use the internet safely and sensibly so that it does not bring harm to them or others.

As a parent, I will:

- Notify the school if, for any reason, my child cannot attend.
- Take an active interest in all aspects of my child's school life.

- Communicate to school all relevant information which may affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure my child follows the school's behaviour policy and support associated action taken by the school.

 - Update the school with any changes to personal details including mobile phone numbers and address.
